Central Florida Community Pet Clinic was created when covid forced the founders of Celery City Cat Café to pivot in order to fill a need in the community. At the last board meeting in December, 2020 the idea of a low cost spay/neuter clinic was brought up because one of the founders was having a difficult time finding TNR appointments (trap-neuter-return) for community cats as well as appointments for sick kittens. Within a few months of the idea, a lease was signed. We had our opening date on **May 6, 2021**!

Since our opening in 2021, we have performed over **9,000 low-cost spay and neuter surgeries**. Central Florida Community Pet Clinic adheres to the standards for Spay/Neuter Medical Care Guidelines by the Association of Shelter Veterinarians' Veterinary Task Force to Advance Spay/Neuter. Core vaccines and pain medication are included in our surgery prices.

Our walk-in wellness clinic has seen **3,000 patients** since our opening. During our wellness hours, cats and dogs can be seen for services such as vaccines, heartworm testing and heartworm/flea prevention, without an appointment. Currently our walk-in wellness hours are Tuesday through Thursday from 12:30-2:30pm.

We recommend following our Facebook page for schedule changes. Our goal is to continue to grow and be able to offer more hours and services to our community.
