Camp Boggy Creek was **founded in 1996** by Actor Paul Newman and General H. Norman Schwarzkopf, with one simple premise in mind... that every child, no matter their illness, could experience the transformational spirit and friendships that go hand in hand with Camp at no cost to their families.

Our state-of-the-art medical and camp facility sits on 252 acres in the Seminole State Forest. We serve children from a variety of serious medical illness groups including cancer, diabetes, asthma, kidney diseases, spina bifida, epilepsy and more. Our campers come from all over the state and spend a life-changing week or weekend throughout the year. Coming to Camp is transformative as our campers get away from doctor's offices and hospitals and get to experience a wide variety of firsts during Camp. Campers experience the first time riding a horse, first time catching a fish, first time doing archery, and so much more.

Camp Boggy Creek is funded by generous individuals, healthcare partners, corporations, and by grants. Meet One of Our Non-Profit Partners



Hello Friends, my name is Beth Robertson. I am the community outreach manager for **Cookies for Kids' Cancer**. We fund childhood cancer research with Cookies and more.

When 2-year-old Liam Witt was diagnosed with childhood cancer in 2007, his parents Gretchen & Larry were shocked to learn about the lack of effective treatments for pediatric cancers due to insufficient funding. With the help of 250 volunteers, Liam's parents undertook a massive bake-a-thon where they baked and sold 96,000 cookies to raise money for research. That project generated more than \$420,000 and — equally important — raised awareness with people asking how they could help. What the Witt family thought was a one-time project became Cookies for Kids' Cancer.

Today, Cookies for Kids' Cancer is a national 501(c)3 non-profit committed to raising funds for research to develop new, improved, and less toxic treatments for pediatric cancer — the #1 killer of children in the U.S.

Through local events and online cookie sales, Cookies for Kids' Cancer has **granted nearly \$20 million** to date, **funding 120+ research projects** that have led to the availability of **25 new treatments** for children battling cancer today. The organization inspires individuals, organizations, and businesses to join in the fight against pediatric cancer. Since Cookies for Kids' Cancer **launched in 2008**, we've participated in more than 16,000 events in all 50 states and 24 countries.

For over 20 years my family has raised money for childhood cancer research, and I have been available for families as a resource and a friend. Cameron, my first born, was diagnosed with a one in a million-liver cancer after a routine, annual wellness checkup. I know what families experience; the swirling questions that loom throughout treatment and after. I chose to be a voice for these families and continued in the fight after Cameron was cancer free.

Funding childhood cancer research is a TOGETHER thing. We cannot make a difference without supporters hosting events, bake sales, purchasing and gifting our cookies and getting involved in any way.

Our treatments are available in Children's Oncology Group Hospitals. There are 3 in the Orlando area. Kids are receiving less toxic more, effective treatments. CFKC brings **HOPE** to kids with cancer with cookies. It's a sweet way to help kids be kids. Look forward to meeting and hearing from you.


